Academic Assessment & Accountability Performance

The 2018-2019 school was the seventh year that Lakeland Academy offered instructional services to students. Lakeland uses multiple assessment instruments to monitor student progress. The school administers on-site mandatory state achievement, screening diagnostic, and graduation tests throughout the year. Lakeland also uses curriculum based formative assessments during each of the quarterly grading period. Evaluation batteries are completed and annual Individual Education Plan reviews are administered for all exceptional needs students. Based on the results of the 3rd grade guarantee and the state end of course exams we show that math, ELA and science are our largest areas of concern and more preparation will be needed.

Lakeland received a C on its most recent state report card. Our highlights were an A in progress and gap closing. No other school locally received a higher report card grade. Our star diagnostic testing also shows adequate annual growth by our students.

Lakeland Academy is in compliance with all rules and laws that are applicable to community schools. All statewide tests are administered according to dates/guidelines established according to the Department of Education. The school has submitted complete accurate and timely data to O.D.E. including all required documentation.

Financial Plan & Performance

Lakeland is in a strong fiscal position. Based on the standard rule of thumb of 45 days out being in good financial condition, Lakeland is over 100 days out.

Lakeland received \$97,346 in Federal Grants. Those funds were used for instruction purposes for Title, Special Education and Tutor needs.
